All material submitted as part of any nomination and the copyright in such material shall become the property of AIM.

Judging

11. The panel of judges will comprise of employee(s) of AIM. The judging panels’ decision is final.
12. AIM reserves the right to request further information and/or evidence in support of a nomination.
13. All nominations must be received by midnight (GMT) Friday 23 August 2024. Nominations not submitted in accordance with these terms and conditions and/or the Eligibility Criteria and/or incomplete or illegible entries will be disqualified.
14. Shortlisted nominations will be announced by AIM week commencing 2 September 2024.
15. Winners will not be announced until the AIM Conference and Awards on 15 October 2024.

The prizes

16. The 2024 AIM Awards winners will receive a trophy and certificate.
17. Any commendations by the judging panel will receive a certificate.
18. There are no cash alternatives and prizes are non-transferrable.

Liability

19. AIM accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss, liabilities, injury or disappointment incurred or suffered by you as a result of entering the competition or accepting any prize.
20. AIM shall not be liable for any damage, loss or disappointment suffered by any person taking part or not being able to take part in the Awards.
