Safety - XAMS

There are adaptations that can be applied to the assessments taking place in the 2021-22 academic year. This means that the specific areas mentioned below can be applied but the rest of the qualification must be completed and evidenced in full.

Qualifications which have been designated as being in category A have been reviewed by the team at AIM and where appropriate, professional body guidance sought to confirm that the adaptations would be accepted.

The following qualifications now include adapted assessment.

XAMS assessed qualifications

AIM Qualifications Level 1 Award in Health and Safety in a Construction Environment	601/4240/6
AIM Qualifications Level 2 Award in Food Safety in Catering	600/8219/7
AIM Qualifications Level 2 Award in Health and Safety in the Workplace	600/4325/8

The adaptation guidance is for all the above listed qualifications whose components are assessed externally via the AIM Qualifications XAMS online multiple- choice questions (MCQs).

The adaptation is in the invigilation of the exam which now allows centres to invigilate remotely or through proctoring.

If you wish to conduct invigilation through either of those options, you must contact your Centre Lead to talk about your system before you can start an assessment.
